

## **Call for Papers - Migration and Religion**

## Special Session: Migration and Religious Ritual 7 to 10 September 2022 Rabat, Morocco

The conveners of the Religion and Migration track of The Migration Conference welcome papers for a special session on the topic of Migration and Religious Ritual. The focus of the section will be on changes to religious ritual in contexts of migration. The session calls on researchers to shed light on understandings of the role and changes of religious rituals in the migration process. Within this special session, debates on the change of religious rituals are expected to reflect migration paradigms and their theological, cultural, and socio-political implications in an interdisciplinary context. We encourage papers that present ritual evolution in contexts of sending, transit, and resettlement. Time scopes are open to modern and historical periods.

## **Abstract Submissions**

The deadline for abstract submission for this special session is **March 1, 2022**. The Migration Conference will take place in English with several tracks available in Spanish, German, Turkish and French. All papers presented at the conference must be original and not simultaneously submitted to another conference. Structured abstracts (up to 500 words) are invited for submission. Abstracts should clearly state the objectives, referring to relevant literature, methods, results, and conclusions of the work, and should be no more than 500 words in length.
