Contributions of Islamic Theological research to the development of religious education theory

CONCEPTS AND MODELS FOR TEACHING CONTEMPORARY RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Islamic theological research and Islamic religious education pedagogy are interrelated – on the one hand, theological research without a view to practice would prove to be theory-heavy; on the other hand, an Islamic religious education pedagogy that does not take into account impulses from theological research would be incomplete. For contemporary religious education, it is necessary to continue thinking about reflected approaches from a contextual theology within Islamic religious education in order to develop didactic and religious education models that find their justification in a pluralistic society. Both disciplines face the challenge of redefining their own traditional patterns of interpretation against this background.

For this reason, a conference on 21st October 2023 will explore which approaches can be derived from Islamic theological research for the development of religious education theory and which concepts and models are indispensable for the teaching of contemporary religious education. The papers presented at the conference and other articles will be published by Springer-Verlag in a volume of the series “Wiener Beiträge zur Islamforschung” (Viennese Contributions to Islamic Research) in order to make them internationally accessible.

We invite all colleagues who deal theoretically or practically with one of the topics mentioned to enrich the planned publication with a contribution in German or English. Theoretical contributions as well as practical reports and research results on the above-mentioned topics are welcome.
